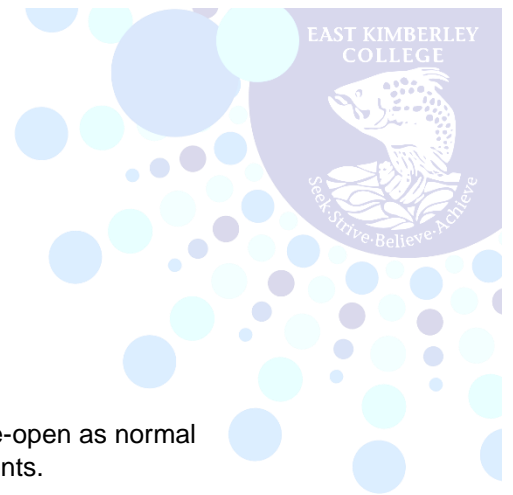


# COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Update 7

Dear Parents and Guardians

This afternoon, the Premier and Minister for Education announced schools will re-open as normal from the beginning of Term 2 and will provide face-to-face education for all students.

Families may still exercise choice in relation to what they believe is in the best interests of their child/children during the COVID-19 pandemic and therefore, you may elect to send your students to school for normal face-to-face education, or alternatively, you may continue to keep them at home. All Year 11 and 12 students are strongly encouraged to attend school for face-to-face classes.

In light of this announcement, the College Executive Team has met to commence the necessary decision making in order to successfully navigate the recent expectations placed upon us for the commencement of Term 2. As always, we remain committed to leading with calm caution and an agile mindset.
